

## **HARK Suggested Tuesday Net Script (6/29/20)**

Good evening! This is <name & call sign>, net control for tonight's Hassayampa Amateur Radio Klub Net. This net is held Tuesday nights at 7:30 P.M. on the HARK club repeater on Yarnell Hill at 146.620 MHz, with 162.2 PL.

This is a directed net. Please pass all traffic through Net Control. Stations with emergency or priority traffic may break in at any time. Is there any emergency or priority traffic? (Listen...). If an emergency should arise, please say "BREAK - EMERGENCY" for immediate Net Control recognition.

HARK meetings and weekly Wednesday luncheons remain suspended. This net meets Tuesday nights at 7:30 P.M. and we meet again Wednesdays at noon with a different chat topic each week. We very much appreciate everyone checking-in to keep in touch and check our radios.

### **CHECK-INS:**

Let's get people checked in. Please give your call sign only, then when called, give any QSTs and indicate if you have items for the Swap so I may call you back for those.

Take check-ins (pause):

- Board members?
- ARRL officials?
- Club members?
- Who else would like to join tonight?

Log all call signs to call back then call each in order to check in. Make another call for check-ins after everyone is called (and call each).

### **QSTs:**

Re-announce any QSTs and ask for any more.

### **SWAP:**

Ask again if anyone has any items to list for the SWAP.

If there are items to list, please announce that "HARK provides the vehicle whereby licensed hams can sell or buy amateur radio items, or obtain amateur radio information, but has no financial interest in any of these transactions."

### SWAP (Continued):

If there are SWAP items, please announce there are a couple of considerations before we begin:

- Give your name, call sign, telephone number or internet address before announcing your transaction;
- If more than one item, tell us how many and describe each in detail including manufacturer, model, condition and price;
- Or, if you have a Want, tell us what it is (item or information) in detail;
- At the end, please repeat your name, call sign, phone number or Internet address.

Call anyone who said they have SWAP items.

Ask for anyone else with SWAP items?

Any additional check-ins for tonight's Net?
