Log all call signs to call back, then call EACH to check in. Make another call for check-ins after everyone is called. Do another round (optional).

QSTs:

Re-announce any QSTs and ask for any more.

SWAP:

Ask if anyone has any items to list for the SWAP...?

Note those who want to list something.

- Anyone else with SWAP items?
- Any more check-ins for tonight's Net?
